- A bachelor's degree in any field from an accredited educational institution in Thailand or overseas
- Applicants with at least one year of relevant work experience are preferred, particularly those working in research, public policy, or social development
- English language proficiency in accordance with Graduate School regulations



STUDY PLAN



PLAN A: ACADEMIC TRACK

- 36 credits (24 coursework credits + 12 thesis credits)
- Designed for future researchers, academics, and policy analysts



PLAN B: PROFESSIONAL TRACK

- 36 credits (30 coursework credits + 6 independent study credits)
- Designed for mid-career professionals, government officials, NGO staff, and development practitioners
